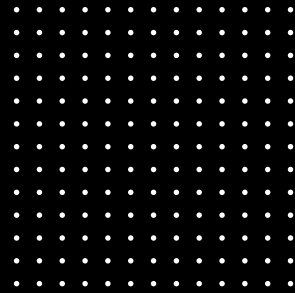

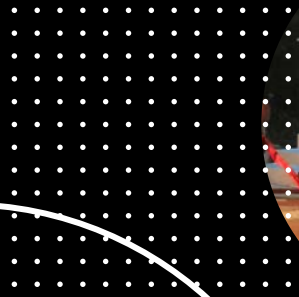

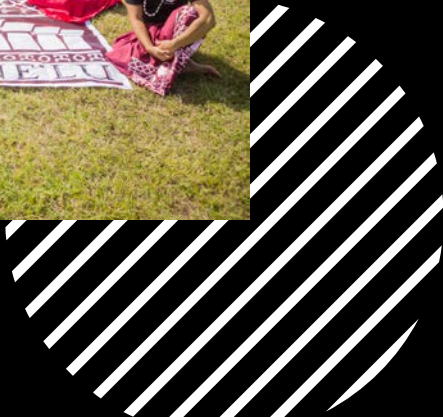
Earn Money!
